Mills announces reduction of ownership

Rio de Janeiro, September 22, 2017 - Mills Estruturas e Serviços de Engenharia S.A. (Mills) informs that it received on September 19, 2017, a letter from FAMA Investimentos Ltda (FAMA), registered under CNPJ/MF under the nº 00.156.956/0001-87, located at Rua Olimpíadas nº 134, conjunto 42, 4º floor, ZIPCODE 04551-000, in the state and city of São Paulo, under the terms of CVM Instruction No. 358/2002, as amended by the CVM Instruction CVM Instruction 449/07 and 568/15, that its investment funds and portfolios managed by it alienated common shares issued by Mills, in negotiations on the trading floor of the Bolsa de Valores de São Paulo-B3, holding a total amount of 8,744,543 common shares. The consolidated participation of investment funds and portfolios managed by FAMA currently represents 4.98% of the total common shares of Mills.

FAMA also informs that (i) does not hold subscription warrants, shares subscription rights, stock options and debentures convertible in shares issued by the Company; and (ii) did not sign agreement or contract regulating the exercise of voting rights or the purchase and sale of securities issued by the Company.
